- Security screening Facial recognition verifies identity instantly, eliminating document checks and reducing wait times.
- Immigration/passport control Facial scans match passengers against their travel records, strengthening border security while also speeding up departure and arrival processing.
- Lounge access Eligible travellers access VIP lounges with a facial scan, linked to loyalty programmes for personalised service.
- Boarding At the gate, passengers board by simply looking into a camera. Identity is confirmed and linked to the flight within seconds, removing manual processing entirely.


Where human checks can be inconsistent, facial recognition systems stay sharp – confirming identities in seconds with reliable precision.
